Two suspects got out of the suspect vehicle and fled on foot. The Wapato Officer took one into custody that was hiding in an irrigation canal and then tracked the second suspect who was hiding near a residence. Both suspects had felony warrants; one of the suspects was wanted for a shooting that occurred in the City of Wapato. The second suspect was involved in the burglary and weapons offense on Egan Lane.
