WAPATO 2015 HARVEST FESTIVAL PARADE RULES AND REGULATIONS

MAIN PARADE


- A. Registration begins between 8:00 and 8:30 a.m. Monday morning (Labor Day). Coffee and donuts will be available at the registration table near the center of the front parking lot of the Wapato High School.
- B. You will receive a numbered parking space for your entry. It is recommended that you come early to insure preparation and visitation time with other parade entries before the parade.
- C. The parade will start at 10 a.m. You are requested to be in or near your parade entry by 9:30 a.m. Community Floats only: If you are a community float you must also be at your float at 9:15 am to be judged.
- D. Once the parade begins, watch for directions from parade officials and try to maintain a 50 foot (15 yard) distance between you and the entry in front of you as you proceed through the parade route.

DURING THE PARADE

- A. Entries will follow the direction and instructions of parade officials and / or law enforcement officers as needed to coordinate the event.
- B. No materials (candy, toys, etc.) can be thrown from vehicles. If you have materials for parade watchers you are allowed to have walkers who may escort your entry and may pass out literature or candy.
- C. Please keep a close eye on the entry in front of you and maintain a 50-foot space between them.
- D. With the exception of bands and drill teams, this is a forward moving parade. No stopping is allowed for any reason, although parade participants might expect delays around the announcement area.
- E. Alcoholic beverages are forbidden in any entry.
- F. The Parade committee reserves the right to withdraw or deny the opportunity to participate to any entry for costumes, performance, language, or appearance that do not meet the standards of reasonable public taste.
- G. No political messages are allowed unless the parade application has been marked under the political category.
- H. All participants standing on floats must be wearing a safety belt or have handholds while the float is moving.
- I. Have a good time and smile a lot.

Staging will be at the front entrance of the Wapato High School (9th Street and Satus Ave.)
From US 97 take either of the signals into Wapato. Find the intersection of 9th Street and Satus Avenue and turn into the High School parking lot. From I-82 go straight down Wapato Ave (Main Street) to 9th Street, take a right to Satus Ave. and a left into the High School Parking lot.
