City of Wapato Trader Street Traffic Advisories

The City's contractor DW Excavating, Inc. will start construction of Trader Street on Wednesday, April 26, 2017. The project will be completed by the end of August. Vehicles are advised to avoid the area.

Trader Street will remain open to traffic during construction. But the contractor may close one lane or both lanes if necessary. Detour routes will be signed and enforced during this time. Business accesses will be kept open. Please plan your driving accordingly and drive safely.

The Trader Street project will include reconstruction of a 2-lane asphalt roadway with curb and gutter, adding sidewalk on the southwest side of the street, and storm water drainage. The contract amount for Trader Street is approximately \$615,000. Funding is from Washington State Transportation Improvement Board (TIB) grant and City of Wapato Transportation Benefit District (\$20 vehicle license fees).

On March 6, 2017, the Wapato City Council passed Resolution 2017-18 to rename **Trader Street** as **Jesse Farias Way** in honor of former Mayor Farias, who has honored Wapato with his vision and energy. The new street name plates will be installed as part of the construction contract.
