## TEMPORARY WATER OUTAGE NOTICE

**S. Camas Ave between 5<sup>th</sup> St. and 9<sup>th</sup> St, including residential houses, Apas Goudy Subdivision, Wapato Irrigation Project, Yakama Nation Housing Authority, and City Public Works Shop.**

Dear Water Customers:

A shut down of the water main on S. Camas Ave between 5<sup>th</sup> St. and 9<sup>th</sup> St. must be conducted as part of the water main construction project. The contractor will connect the new water main to the existing water system on Wednesday, May 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2017. Water service will be interrupted (shut off) between the hours of 8:00am and 2:00pm.

Please be advised that this interruption may last for the entire period or for just a portion of the time frame listed above. You may also experience intermittent disruptions of water pressure. Normal water service will be restored to your area as soon as the contractor completes the necessary work. After water service is restored you may experience some air and or discoloration of the water. This is to be expected and can be corrected by running your cold faucets for a while until the air is gone and/or the water clears up.

If you have a fire system you may experience low fire system pressure which may cause an alarm on your fire system. You may need to notify your fire alarm company of this situation to avoid an unnecessary alarm. Wapato Middle School, the three elementary schools, and Blessed Kateri Village will have water, but the pressure may be low.
